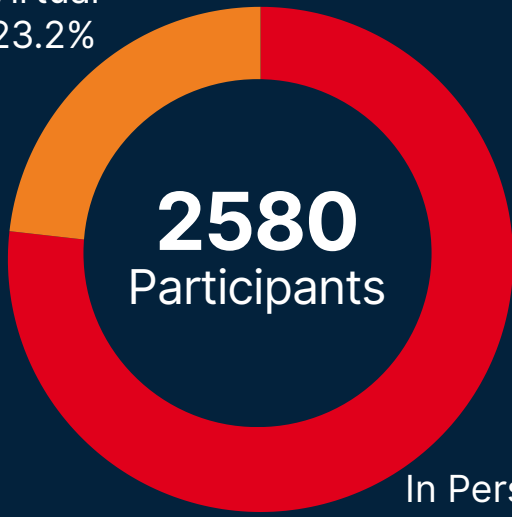

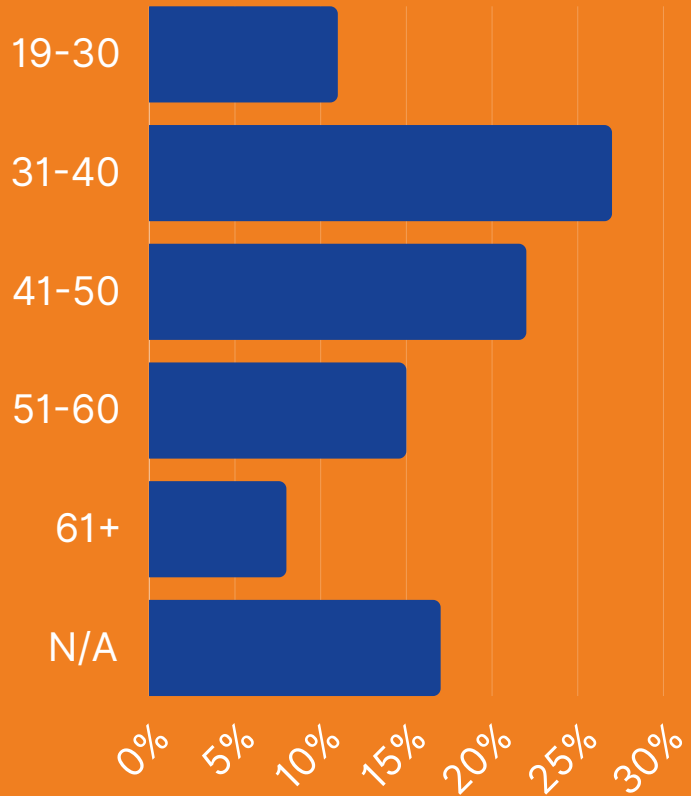

## Delegates by Age



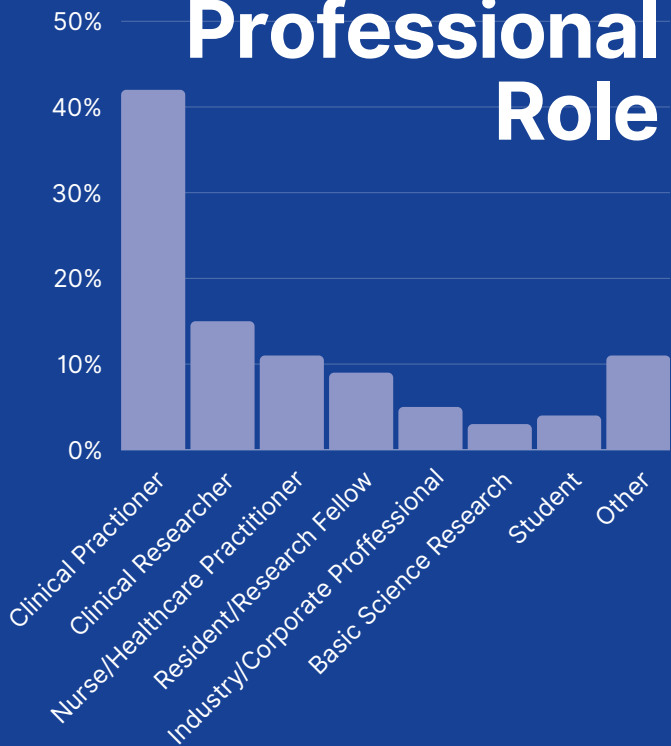

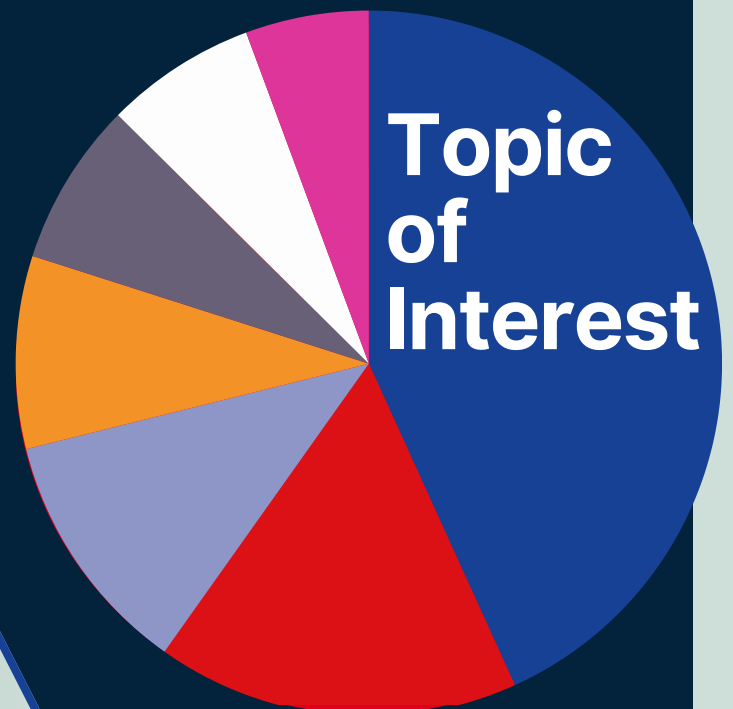
