Focus Country: has formal designation of engagement with GICC, recognized in writing between the governments and WHO. These countries receive full technical and funding support from WHO and St Jude Children's Research Hospital.

Focus countries should ideally demonstrate early measurable progress, with advances in one or more of the Initiative's CureAll pillars/enablers.

Countries with activities: engaged in clearly defined CureAll project(s) or activities linked to one or more CureAll pillars/enablers, including receiving technical and/or financial support from St. Jude directly, or from WHO- St. Jude's Agreement without a formal letter or designation of engagement to qualify as a Focus Country.

Countries in Dialogue: Country working with WHO or St. Jude or both, with expressed interest in strengthening childhood cancer control and engaging in GICC exploratory dialogues concerning the Initiative. Not yet engaging in clearly defined GICC CureAll Pillars/Enablers implementation
